Year 1 Curriculum Overview – Autumn 2



Maths

This half term, we will start by focusing on our addition and subtraction skills. We will learn different techniques to support ourselves as well as exploring the relationship between addition and subtraction.

We will then move on to looking at time. We will think about what a day, week and month consists of before learning about an analogue clock.


We will finish this half term by starting to explore shape.

English

In English this half term, we will be continuing to use our phonics skills to spell words accurately. We will also be working on remembering to use capital letters, full stops and finger spaces in our sentences.

We will be retelling familiar stories and holding our sentences in our head. We will also be writing letters to Santa and as well as a description of him.

In reading, we will be making predictions and discussing new vocabulary. We will continue to learn new sounds in our phonics sessions.



RE

In RE this half term, we will be exploring 'what do Christians believe God is like?'. We will look at different Bible stories to explore what Christians think about God.

PE

In PE this half-term, we will be improving our hand-eye coordination by focusing on different passes and catching.

PHSE

In PHSE this half-term, we will be learning about healthy relationships and lifestyles with Miss Young.

Geography

In geography, we will be learning about Springwell Village. We will identify our local landmarks on a map as well as completing our own maps.

Science

In science, we will continue to observe seasonal changes. We will also be looking at different animals and how they are classified. We will also look at some animal's diets.

Music

In music, we will be learning how to keep a steady beat and follow simple rhythmic patterns.

DT

In DT this half term, we will be learning all about sliders and leavers and use this knowledge to design and create our own moving pictures.
