

Year 1 Curriculum Overview – Autumn 2

Maths

This half term, we will be learning about time. We will study the days of the week, sequence a day and read o'clock and half past the hour times. We will then move onto recognising, naming and sorting 2D and 3D shapes. Finally, we will begin our place value unit to 50. We will recognise how many tens and ones are within a number, order the numbers and compare them.

English

In English this half term, we will be continuing to use our phonics skills to spell words accurately. We will also be working on using capital letters, full stops and finger spaces in our sentences.

We will be retelling familiar stories and holding our sentences in our head.

In reading, we will be making predictions and discussing new vocabulary. We will continue to learn new sounds in our phonics sessions.



Geography

In geography, we will be learning about Springwell Village. We will use an ordnance survey map to locate features within the village and track our route to school. We will then make our own blocked map of the school's ground.

Science

In science, we will be studying everyday materials. We will identify what objects are made of and why. We will explore the use of materials and discuss their properties.

Music

In music, we will be learning how to keep a steady beat and follow simple rhythmic patterns.

DT

In DT this half term, we will be learning all about sliders and levers and use this knowledge to design and create our own moving pictures.

RE

In RE this half term, we will be exploring 'what do Christians believe God is like?' We will look at different Bible stories to explore what Christians think about God and even have our own christening in church to show how Christians show their love to God.

PE

In PE this half-term, we will be improving our hand-eye coordination by focusing on different passes and catching.

PHSE

In PHSE this half-term, we will be learning about healthy relationships and lifestyles with Miss Young.

- Use Phonics Play Obb and Bob to read real and nonsense words.
- Say one number below 10 and your child can say the other number that makes it a bond to 10!
- Read your home reader weekly.
