### **Residentials**

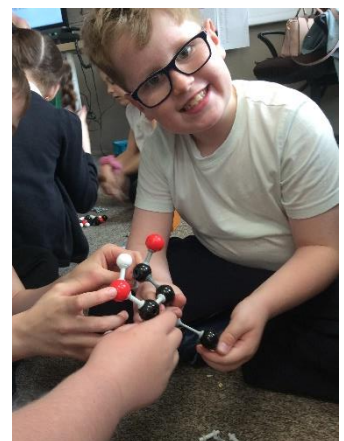
We are in the process of finalising the travel costs for the year 4, 5 and 6 residentials, and letters and payment plans will be out next week.
