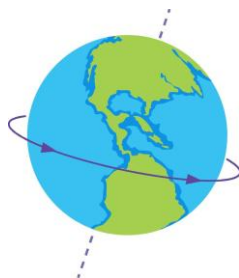


# Year 1 Curriculum Overview – Summer 2

## Maths

This half term, we will be applying our place value knowledge to numbers within 100. We will continue to apply our knowledge to reasoning with our maths challenges.

We will then move on to recognising and using money. We will use our skills of counting in 2s, 5s and 10s to help us find the correct amount and work out change.



## Geography

In geography this half term, we will be learning all about the Equator. We will learn about how the temperature and seasons differ from countries closest and furthest from the Equator. We will be looking at different maps, books and online sources to help us with our research.

## RE

In RE this half term, we will explore 'How should we care for the world and for others, and why does it matter?' We will learn about how lots of different communities show they care.

## Science

In science, we will be continuing our plants topic. We will be working scientifically to observe how our newly planted seeds grow over time.

## English

In English this half term, we will write a three-part story as well as a recount and a set of instructions.

We will continue to focus on writing in sentences with the correct punctuation and spelling tricky words correctly.

In reading, we will be making predictions and discussing new vocabulary.

In phonics we will be preparing for the phonics screening check by revising all relevant phonemes, identifying phonemes in words and identifying alien and real words.

## PE

In PE this half term, we will be focusing on our athletic skills in the run up to sports day. We will be learning how to run and move in different ways.

## Music

In music this half term, we will be using our music knowledge to compose and sing a known song.

## Computing

In computing this half term, we will be learning to use a laptop and complete challenges on Purple Mash.

## DT

In DT this half term, we will be designing and making a fruit salad. We will learn about where fruits grow and taste a variety of fruit. We will learn how to prepare the fruit safely.

## How to get involved at home

- Use Phonics Play Obb and Bob to read real and nonsense words.
- Observe flowers and trees in the local area and identify them. You could go to a garden centre to look at the different kinds of plants and trees there.
- Read your home reader weekly and practise your homework sounds.
