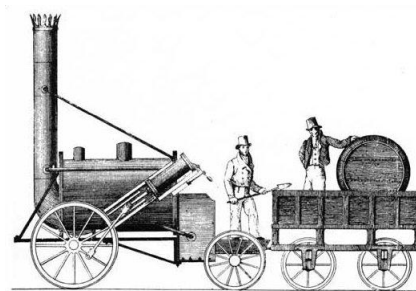


# Year 1 Curriculum Overview – Autumn 1



## Maths

This half term, we will focus on place value to 10. We will learn about different ways to represent numbers as well as how to show comparisons of different values. We will also practise counting forwards and backwards from a given number within 10 and find one more and one less than a number within 10. We will then move on to addition, focusing on number bonds within 10.

## English

In English this half term, we will be using our phonics skills to spell words accurately. We will also be practising using capital letters, full stops and finger spaces in our sentences.

We will retell familiar stories as well as some familiar recounts. We will also be practising our handwriting and fine motor skills daily.

In reading, we will be making predictions and discussing new vocabulary. We will continue to learn new sounds in our phonics sessions.

## RE

In RE this half term, we will be exploring 'what does it mean to belong to a faith/ community?'. We will look at what makes a community and roles and responsibilities people have within it.

## PE

In PE this half-term, we will be improving our hand-eye coordination by focusing on throwing with accuracy and catching.

## PHSE

In PHSE this half-term, we will be learning about understanding our feelings and emotions with Miss Savage.

## History

In history, we will learn about the lives of significant others and the impact that they had on the world. We will learn about George Stephenson and what he created. We will then discuss how this would have changed Britain.

## Science

In science, we will learn about the human body. We will learn to name different body parts and about the five senses. We will then look at seasonal change as summer turns into autumn.

## Music

In music, we will be learning how to keep a steady beat and follow simple rhythm patterns.

## Art

In art this half term, we will learn to mix colours and make tints. We will learn about Wassily Kandinsky and create our own paintings inspired by his work.

## How to get involved at home

- Use Phonics Play Obb and Bob to read real and nonsense words.
- Say a number and then say one more and one less.
- Read your home reader weekly.
- Talk about changes you are seeing as the seasons change.
