Pantomime Information

We are looking forward to visiting the Customs House next Friday, 5th December, to see Goldilocks and the Three Bears. Thank you to those of you who have paid the subsidised cost of £10. If you are still yet to pay, we would be grateful if you could do so via ParentPay as soon as possible. Thank you in advance.



Coaches will be arriving at school to collect children in years 1 to 6 at 8:50am and we will be leaving at 9:05am. We ask that parents and carers move any parked vehicles at drop off time as quickly as possible so that the coaches can get parked. Also, children will need to arrive promptly at school as unfortunately we are running to a tight time schedule and will be unable to wait for any children arriving late. Children should wear school uniform as normal.

If you are happy to do so, you can provide your child with a small packet of sweets to enjoy during the pantomime. We ask that you provide sweets rather than chocolate as we do have children with a
